8. Are nonresident aliens in the crew listed on the same I-418 as resident alien crew?
9. Do nonresident aliens need a Visa prior to being signed on as crew? If so, who issues the Visa?
10. What type of document needs to be prepared prior to arrival at the first US Port for each nonresident alien crewmember?
